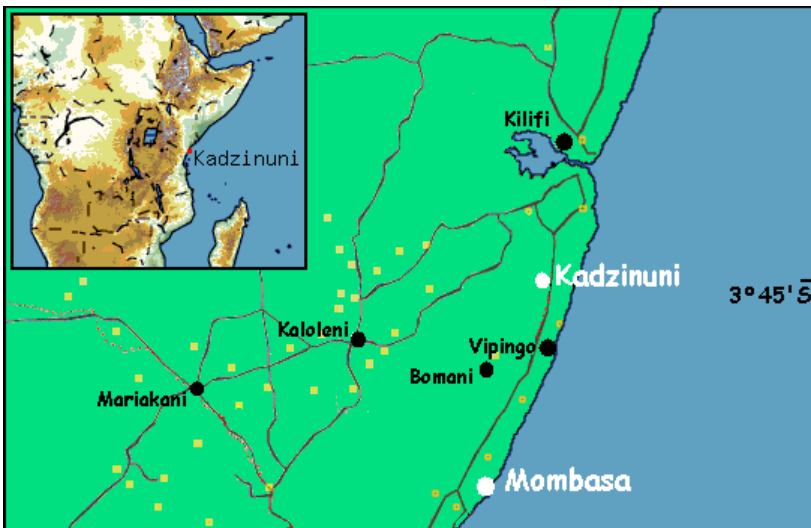

Kadzinuni is located just a few kilometres north of the small town of Vipingo, about one hour's drive from Mombasa, the busiest port of East Africa. The village is located on a low ridge, only about two kilometres from the white sandy beaches of the India Ocean. The village is set on the edge of a massive Sisal plantation, which provides some of the local people with casual work throughout the year.

The Friends of Kadzinuni is a UK registered charity solely dedicated to supporting Kadzinuni through Healthcare, Education and Community development.

Run Kendricks for a day!



Our input on an average day will be between £20 and £30. You can help by donating £25, perhaps as a birthday or anniversary gift for a family member or friend. You will receive a gift card to send to the person on whose behalf you donate, or we can send it direct to them for you. Tell us the special date and we'll ensure that the donor and friends names will be placed in the special diary at Kadzinuni, recognising the gift.

Buy a pack of 3 mosquito nets

£6

Malaria remains the biggest single killer disease in Africa. £6 will allow us to buy 3 lifetime-impregnated nets. These both ward off these killer insects with a physical barrier and also drive them off via the repellent in which they have been soaked. They will be distributed via the nurse at Kendrick's. You will receive a gift card to send to the person on whose behalf you donated the nets, or we can send it direct to them for you.

Corporate gift? Run Kendricks for a whole month!

£500 will provide the funds we need to sustain Kendricks for a whole month! Your company or organisation can support the reduction of poverty and disease at Kadzinuni in this way, you nominate a particular month and year which will be recognised by the placing of your company name on the clinic entrance. For the month nominated we will recognise your support on The Friends of Kadzinuni home page and place a permanent entry on our Business Friends page. Our website can also carry a link to your own website or email address. You will also receive a framed Friends Award certificate.

Healthcare at Kadzinuni

In August 2007 the clinic dedicated to the memory of one of original trustees Kendrick Seller opened.. It provides basic care, medication and a wide range of preventive and health education services to the whole community of Kadzinuni at minimal cost. We hope to subsidise those who cannot afford to pay. The Kenya Ministry of Health provides our Nurse, Cleaner and Watchman; we have built and equipped *Kiliniki Ya Kendrick* (Kendrick's Clinic). We have to maintain the buildings, subsidise consultations, provide support for health education and develop facilities further.

In the first 12 months of operation Kendrick's provided 19,798 appointments!

Buy a desk

In 2007 at least 2 new classrooms are being built at Kadzinuni. That means that we need to help them provide up to 80 new desks, otherwise the students will sit on the floor! £20 will buy a locally made strong desk of wood on a metal frame with built in seat big enough for 2 students to work at. Spending your donation in the local economy also means that the money circulates and helps many other people, not just the students. You will receive a gift card to send to the person on whose behalf you donated the desk, or we can send it direct to them for you.

Buy some books

Kadzinuni Primary School needs books to increase its stock and replace those that wear out in the harsh climate of Kenya coast. Since 2006 we have established a Community Library in the Community Centre Building adjacent to Kendricks Clinic. £15 will buy a Gift of Books, allowing the purchase of between 2 and 6 items for school or community.

In addition to the gift card for you or your friend/family member we prepare and send out special bookplates to stick in each book containing a short dedication. The gift card will include a copy of the bookplate.

Education at Kadzinuni

Kadzinuni Primary School is a vibrant happy place, packed with nearly 1,000 children aged 5 to about 17. It first opened in 1923 and it has grown rapidly since attendance fees were abolished a few years ago. Sadly some classes contain over 100 students, with 3 to a desk! They are so hungry for a good education that some children even use the class rooms on Saturdays and Sundays in informal sessions learning from each other, without the teachers.



Sponsor a student to go to secondary school

The Friends of Kadzinuni has set up a scheme to provide financial support to those able students that on completion of Grade 8 at Kadzinuni then qualify for a Provincial or National Secondary School place. Secondary education in Kenya is only available to those who can afford to pay fees. Young people from Kadzinuni rarely have the resources to attend secondary school. The curriculum at secondary school is a 4 year course.

The scheme commenced during 2005 with the Friends supporting 11 students. We are supporting 12 more from January 2007 and another 12 from January 2008. We have to accumulate at least one year's school fees per student before we start so that we can guarantee support. (The school year starts in January). You can read some extracts from their letters on our website. Just click on the Class of 2006 page.

We are currently seeking people to join during 2008 for students starting in January 2009 and beyond and expect that supporters will usually choose to make regular monthly gifts that for UK taxpayers can be subject to Gift Aid, increasing the value of the gift by at least 28%.

£12 per month (if Gift Aided, or £15 if not) for 48 months will fully cover the Secondary School fees for a Kadzinuni student. You can also pay annually.

The sponsored student agrees to certain conditions such as:

- ❖ At least one letter per term to the sponsor(s) explaining about life at school.
- ❖ Agreement to do some voluntary work at Kadzinuni, as agreed with a member of the Kadzinuni Rotary Community Corps., local villagers and our partners in the project.
- ❖ Agreement to undertake at least four weeks of voluntary work in Kadzinuni Primary School, mentoring Standard 8 students as they work towards their final exams.
- ❖ Agreement from the student's parents/carer to cultivate at least 10 tree seedlings per year that their child is supported, to be planted in Kadzinuni.
- ❖ Ongoing support from year to year will be conditional on a good attendance record and a level of progress indicative of the student working hard. Exam results will be part of the criteria but not of overriding importance.

Buy a sewing machine

The Inua Nyumba Ladies Group is building up small businesses in Kadzinuni, some based on textiles, making clothing for sale. £45 will buy a sturdy hand operated sewing machine that will help one or more ladies become economically active, helping to bring a better quality of life to the village.

Goats thrive in the climate around Kadzinuni. £12 will allow us to help a family by providing them with goat that can provide milk and be used for breeding to create sustainable herds that will bring better food and health to the community. In addition the development of husbandry skills is great for the long term.

Community development at Kadzinuni

The Clinic site is home to a small Community Centre, housing the library and rooms in which the local ladies group meet. Called *Inua Nyumba*, meaning “uplifting the family”, they run small businesses, initially assisted by a Micro Finance scheme. At first just a handful of ladies formed the group. It has now grown to over 20 and a second group is being formed in 2007. In addition the RCC (Rotary Community Corps.) use the centre as a base for the Clinic Committee.

Buy some sports equipment

Sport helps Kadzinuni students' live healthy lives, despite the all year round heat! £15 will buy a couple of footballs, volley balls or help towards replacing the school sports kits. Kadzinuni students seem to have grown at least 2" each in height. Why? It is just the pride of having good kit and proper equipment when they represent their village!

We aim to support the girls and boys equally. Kadzinuni is growing African children with a stronger sense of team work and desire to live healthy and active lives. Sport also helps create leadership skills. One vision we share with these young children is that one day a president of Kenya might come from Kadzinuni!

We are a small organisation that spends no publicly donated money on administration or overheads. We cannot yet take payment by Credit or Debit card. Cash or cheques for one off donations are best. Regular donations can be made by Bank Standing Order. Every penny of the funds donated goes right to front line of our operation, fighting poverty and improving lives at Kadzinuni. We are a completely voluntary organisation and comply with all requirements of the UK Charity Commission. We are happy to supply copies of our latest Annual Report and Accounts at any time.
