How our ethical gifts scheme works

We aggregate your donations over a six-month period then transfer the funds to our partners in Kadzinuni who will use them to purchase the specific items (except in the case of Kendricks Clinic, where your donation helps to cover running costs).

Each year one of our trustees visits Kadzinuni to view the projects and inspect the various project records and accounts. The Inua Nyumba Ladies Group owns the Sewing Machines. The Rotary Community Corps distribute goats and books are held in the Community Library. The School Committee purchases school & sports equipment. Mosquito Nets are purchased and distributed by the clinic.
